More persons employed in trade and in services in 2022

Index of gross wages and salaries and hours worked also increased

Vienna, 2023-04-11 – In 2022, compared with the previous year the number of employment relationships increased by 1.6% in the trade sector and by 6.6% in the service sector, according to Statistics Austria.

Hours worked increased in both the trade sector (+4.9%) and the service sector (+9.8%). Likewise, gross wages and salaries recorded an increase up 6.5% in the trade sector and 11.9% in the service sector compared with 2021. When making comparisons with the prior-year period, it should be noted that a large proportion of companies were affected to varying degrees by closures and other restrictions due to the measures taken against the Corona pandemic.

Information on methodology, definitions: Since the 1st quarter of 2018, the short-term statistics on trade and services have provided the index of gross wages and salaries, which represents gross earnings per reporting quarter and breakdown, and the index of hours worked, which represents hours worked per reporting quarter and breakdown. These indices have the base year 2015 and are published quarterly around 90 days after the end of the reporting period. The employment indicators and their rates of change are measured on the basis of employment ratios - a presentation in and a comparison with full-time equivalents is not possible. These data are available in backward calculations up to 2010.
