Production down by 4.4% in November 2023

Declines in both industry and construction

Vienna, 2024-01-10 – The working-day adjusted production index for industry and construction decreased by 4.4% in November 2023 compared to November of the previous year, according to calculations by Statistics Austria. Against October 2023, it decreased by 1.1% on a seasonally adjusted basis.

In comparison with the **previous month October 2023**, the seasonally adjusted (EU-harmonised) industrial production (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) decreased by 0.9% in November 2023. Compared to October 2023, the main industrial groupings showed the following results: energy +7.2%, consumer non-durables +1.8%, consumer durables -0.1%, capital goods -0.3%, intermediate goods -4.2% (see table 1).

In a **year-on-year** comparison, the working-day adjusted (EU-harmonised) **industrial production index** (ÖNACE 2008 B–E) reached 129.2 points in November 2023 and was therefore 4.3% under the result of November 2022. The working-day adjusted production in **construction** decreased by 4.5% compared to the previous year. Regarding the year-on-year change, the main industrial groupings were subject to the following developments: energy +6.9%, consumer non-durables +2.3%, capital goods –7.3%, intermediate goods –7.9%, consumer durables –8.0% (see table 1).
